

**Selectmen's Minutes**

**February 16, 2007**

Present: Chairman Jeffrey D. Jones, Selectman Mark Lynch (by telephone), and Selectman A. Raymond Randall, Jr.

Also Present: Town Administrator Brendhan Zubricki, Police Chief Peter Silva

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. in the T.O.H.P. Burnham Library and announced that the Board would hear Public Comment. No one present offered any comments.

At 7:31 a.m., citing the need to discuss issues regarding collective bargaining and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 42, the Chairman entertained a motion to hold a Roll Call Vote to move to Executive Session. The Chairman said they would return to regular session later and invited Town Administrator Brendhan Zubricki and Police Chief Peter Silva to attend. The motion was moved, seconded, and per a Roll Call Vote, the Board moved to Executive Session. (Selectman Mark Lynch did not vote.)

The Board returned to regular session at 8:05 a.m.

Mr. Zubricki presented a letter of interest received from Mark Thompson regarding the vacancy on the Conservation Commission. The Selectmen decided to advise Mr. Thompson that they would keep his letter on file, but that they could not accept his letter since it was past the deadline for receiving letters for the current vacancy.

There being no other business before the Board, a motion was made, seconded, and unanimously Voted to adjourn the meeting.
