Present: Chairman Jeffrey D. Jones, Selectman Lisa J. O'Donnell, Town Administrator Brendhan Zubricki, Town Counsel Gregg Corbo, and Finance Committee Chairman Jeffrey Soulard.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. in the Teachers' Lounge of the Essex Elementary School and announced that the Board would hear Public Comment. There was no one present from the public to offer comment.

Mr. Zubricki began his presentation of his Town Administrator's Report for the period April 21st, 2012 through May 4th, 2012 regarding the following:

A motion was made, seconded, and unanimously voted to reappoint Trescott DeWitt to the Department of Public Works for a term of 3 years, effective May 15, 2012.

A motion was made, seconded, and unanimously voted to remove the entirety of the clam flat known as "The Spit" from the list of designated winter flats. Effective May 13th, 2012, the entire Spit will be designated as a year-round clam flat.

A motion was made, seconded, and unanimously voted to approve a request from the Friends of the Council on Aging to waive the rental fee and to approve the rental of Centennial Grove for their annual BBQ on Thursday, June 14, 2012, from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The Selectmen discussed the status of Special Legislation regarding Conomo Point with Representative Ferrante, who had joined the meeting.

A motion was made, seconded, and unanimously voted to approve the following requests for permits and licenses:

There being no further business before the Board, at 7:15 p.m., a motion was made, seconded, and unanimously voted to adjourn the Selectmen's meeting and to move to attend the Annual Town Meeting in the gymnasium.
