The Fairhaven Board of Appeals met on February 7, 2012 at 6:00 PM at the Fairhaven Town Hall. Members present were: Mr. Rene Fleurent, Jr., Mr. Kenneth Kendall, Mr. Al Silva, Mr. Fran Cox, Mr. Peter DeTerra, Mr. Daryl Manchester and Ms. Peg Cook. The following petition was considered:

Petitioner:Kathleen Curbone6 Morgan StreetPlat 19, Lot 290Book 5723, Page 57198-18Short 32' of the required 45' rear setback and short 8' on the east side of the required 15' side setback in a RB District.

The petition was read. There were 56 abutters notified. The petitioner would like to construct to the rear of the house, a 10'x12' three-season room with a 4' composite deck surrounding three sides. The room and deck will add to the use of the house. The lot is small and a variance is required.

Motion to grant the Variance was made by Mr. Cox; seconded by Mr. Kendall

The Board voted 5-0 to grant a Variance of thirty-two feet (32') of the required forty-five feet (45') rear setback and eight feet (8') on the east side of the required fifteen feet (15') side setback in a RB District as required in the By-Law Section 198-18 for the following reasons:

1.0 The lot is small and a Variance is required for an addition. Not granting the Variance would create a hardship.

2.0 Granting this relief will not derogate from the intent and purpose of the By-Law.

3.0 Granting this relief will not adversely affect the zoning district in which it is located.
