Dr. Bowcock motioned to approve the minutes of November 8, 2007. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.

JIM HOLMES

Members of Jim Holmes' family and friends were in attendance for the dedication of a plaque in his memory. The plaque will be placed in the Banquet Room of the Town Hall. Mr. Manzone read the following:

To a man who truly made a difference in the Town of Fairhaven. Jim served proudly as Assistant Harbormaster, Chairman of the Board of Appeals, member of the Planning Board, member of the Harbor Advisory Committee, member of the Livesey Park Restoration Committee and member of the Sconticut Neck Sewer Committee. Jim's commitment to this community will resonate for years to come. Jim's unique personality made him so approachable to all the citizens. His smile alone said it all; he was a friendly and caring individual who enjoyed being a part of the solution. He was an honest and fair official who loved working with others for the sole reason of making our town a better place to live. Jim's passing has left a void in many of our hearts, but he shall always be remembered for his service and commitment he gave to this town.

Mr. Manzone said Jim was his best friend, a man that cared about people and Fairhaven and was always there to make Fairhaven a better place. The Town has lost a dedicated future leader and he will be deeply missed.

VETERAN OF THE YEAR

The Board congratulated James Leal on being honored as the ninth annual Southeastern Veteran of the Year from the Veterans Transition House. Mr. Leal served in the United States Army as a combat medic during the Korean War. He was awarded the Korean Service Medal, the United Nations Medal, the National Defense Medal and the Bronze Star with Valor. He was involved with the placement of the Korean War Memorial in Clasky Park in New Bedford.

2008 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

Director of Planning and Economic Development was in attendance to answer questions concerning the final draft of the 2008 Fairhaven Community Development Strategy for the 2008 Block Grant. (See attached.) Mr. Silvia motioned to approve the final draft. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous. Mr. Silvia motioned to approve an extension to the 2006 Community Development Block Grant. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.

HARBORMASTER

Shellfish Constable and Harbormaster were present and discussed waterway user fees, Union Wharf permits and fees, moorings and the establishment of an Enterprise Fund. (See attached.)

Mr. Silvia motioned to allow Eric Moniz to dock his boat in his father's slip at Union Wharf for two months while his father's boat is being repaired. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Silvia motioned to approve Union Wharf Basin slips for the following fishermen: Eric Moniz, John Moniz, David Crowley, Arthur DeCosta, Tim Powers, Robert Hobson, Aaron Cebula, Thomas Tomkiewicz and Bruce Ingham. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.

There is one vacancy at Union Wharf for a small vessel. Deadline to submit an application to the attention of Kevin Villa is December 10, 2007.

Mr. Silvia motioned to increase, effective July 1, 2008, the Union Wharf dockage fee for the large boats to \$20.00 per day, \$50.00 per day for transient boats with a maximum consecutive 15 days, or 60 days yearly and payment delinquent 60 days for all large boats will be subject to a penalty of 14%. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Silvia motioned to place an article on the Annual Town Meeting Warrant for an Enterprise Fund for the Office of the Harbormaster. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Silvia motioned that boats trailered in/out on each use will not be charged a waterway user fee, Fairhaven marinas will bill their customers and forward a check to the Town and the marina will receive \$1.00 for each vessel paying a waterway user fee. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Silvia motioned to approve the Rules and Regulations for Dingy Racks with a yearly fee of \$35. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Silvia motioned to direct the Harbormaster to develop a mooring plan. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Silvia motioned to appoint James Hennessy a Deputy Shellfish Warden & Assistant Harbormaster. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous. Term to expire May 31, 2008.

PERSONNEL BOARD

John Nunes, Personnel Director, submitted a memo stating that on November 7th the Personnel Board approved the following requests:

- 1. To add the position of Fire Department Photographer to the budget as of July 1, 2008 (fiscal year 2009) under the heading of "Call Firefighter" as long as there is no increase in the department budget.
- 2. To add the position of Engineer-Part Time to the Board of Public Works Department as of July 1, 2008 (fiscal year 2009). This position will pay \$25 per hour to be funded by the fees that the developers now pay for this service and to add this slot to the Schedule E Salary Schedule of the Personnel By-Laws.
- 3. To support the change of the part time position in the Town Accountants office from a Level 5 Step 5 to a Level 9 Step 4 effective July 1, 2008 (fiscal year 2009) subject to approval by the Board of Selectmen, Finance Committee and Town Meeting.
- 4. To request that the Board of Selectmen have the non-union department heads work a 40 hour week with an hour lunch and to be in Town Hall during the hours of operation.

Discussion ensued on each of the four requests and the Board stated they may approve or reject the request or send the request back to the Personnel Board for additional information. Even if the Board of Selectmen approves a request, Town Meeting and/or the Finance Committee may not fund the change.

Mr. Silvia motioned to approve request #1. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Dr. Bowcock motioned to refer request #2 back to the Personnel Board to request a job description be submitted. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Dr. Bowcock motioned to table request #3. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Dr. Bowcock motioned to table request #4. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.

COALITION FOR BUZZARDS BAY

Mark Rasmussen, Executive Director of the Coalition for Buzzards Bay, was in attendance to discuss the "2007 State of the Bay Report". He reported that increasing nitrogen pollution is causing the decline in the health of Buzzards Bay. Eelgrass is disappearing and bay scallop harvests and river herring populations are near collapse. (See attached information.)
