Deborah Jenkins and the Board of Directors were present to discuss the proposed budget for the COA.

7:30 P.M. – Bruce Ingham/Commercial Dredge Boats

Present were Mr. Ingham, Mr. Allaire, Mr. Sullivan, Mr. Power, Mr. Mills, Mr. Wolfgang, Mr. Souza and Mr. Costa. Also in attendance were Kevin Villa and David Darmofal.

Mr. Ingham presented to the Selectmen several reasons why the recent decision by the Selectmen, as recommended by Mr. Villa, to bar dredge boat shell fishing North of Baxter Ave. as discriminatory and harmful to his livelihood, as well as to other potential dredge boaters.

Mr. Villa read a letter from the DMF supporting the reasons why dredge boat fishing should be restricted from certain areas. Discussion ensued.

Mr. Silvia submitted a Police Incident Report into the record regarding Mr. Ingham's behavior towards Mr. Villa following the Selectmen's decision regarding Baxter Ave. and stated that this was unacceptable behavior. (See attached)

Dr. Bowcock interceded on Mr. Ingham's behalf and stated that he felt that the incident was unfortunate and felt this behavior was out of character for Mr. Ingham but at the same time feels that the Selectmen should retain the control over the Town's natural resources.

Dr. Bowcock motioned to contact the DMF to meet with the Town to develop a set of rules and regulations concerning dredge boats and fishing in certain areas. Mr. Murphy seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Silvia requested to contact the members of the Shellfish Advisory Committee, to see if they are still interested in serving.

Dr. Bowcock motioned to sign release forms concerning two insurance claims regarding two police officers as voted 2/9/09 executive session. Mr. Murphy seconded. Vote was unanimous.

At 8:15 P.M., Dr. Bowcock motioned to go into executive session to discuss negotiations with Clerical Union, Dispatchers, Police, Fire, and a law suit between Medeiros & Sons and BPW; not reconvene in open session. Mr. Murphy seconded. Vote was unanimous. Roll 3-0.
