Fairhaven Board of Selectmen February 15, 2012 Meeting Minutes

The Board then voted to approve several repetitious articles for Annual Town Meeting: Articles 1, 2, 6, 11, 15, 37, 38, 39, 40, 42, 43, 44, 45, and 49 were approved (see attached). Dr. Bowcock motioned, Mr. Murphy seconded. Vote was unanimous. (3-0).

The Board voted to enter Executive Session at 6:29 p.m. Reasons for entering Executive Session was for discussion regarding the Town Accountant position. Dr. Bowcock motioned, Mr. Murphy seconded. Vote was unanimous. Roll call vote: Mr. Silvia in favor. Dr. Bowcock in favor. Mr. Murphy in favor. (3-0).

The Board voted to reconvene into Open Session at 6:48 p.m. The Special Town Meeting took place at 7:00 p.m. (See attached). The Special Town Meeting ended and the Board voted to adjourn at 9:11 p.m. Dr. Bowcock motioned, Mr. Murphy seconded. Vote was unanimous. (3-0).
