

Fairhaven Board of Selectmen April 1, 2014 Meeting Minutes

Present: Chairman Charles Murphy, Vice Chairman Robert Espindola, Clerk Geoffrey Haworth, and Executive Secretary Jeffrey Osuch.

Chairman Charles Murphy called the meeting to order in the Town Hall East Room at 6:35 p.m.

DAVID GONSALVES

The Board discussed the passing of David Gonsalves, elected, seated member of the Fairhaven School Committee. The Board agreed to send flowers. An appointment to fill Mr. Gonsalves' position until the next Election will be made at a joint meeting of the School Committee and the Board of Selectmen.

TOWN FINANCES

General discussion on Town finances followed, including Ambulance Revenues. Mr. Espindola requested that the Board hold the line on expenditures and reduce the budgets as was discussed at a prior meeting. Mr. Haworth stated his opinion had changed and that he was willing to support budgets as requested by raising the Local Receipt estimate to 82% - 83% from 80%. Mr. Murphy was in agreement that the Board should not reduce budget requests and supported increasing Revenue projections on Local Receipts to 82% - 83%.

Mr. Osuch stated that the Town is going in the wrong direction and it was creating a major budget problem for future years by spending more than was available in revenue. He said that the Town will have problems reaching the current Surplus Revenue amounts in future years, meaning the Town will have a deficit and will result in budget cuts and reductions in personnel.

Mr. Haworth stated the economy is picking up and that future revenues will go up.

Mr. Espindola reminded the Board of the conference call that was held with the Town auditing firm, Melanson and Heath, and their warning on expenditures.

Mr. Murphy said that the Town has negotiated contracts with Police, Fire and Schools in good faith and needs to fund the contracts. He stated that the Town needs to start the budget process earlier and in the future, department heads will have to make cuts if funds are not there.

Mr. Osuch repeated that the Town is creating a budget shortfall in future years by not reducing budgets when the discussion was a 2 percent maximum and the auditors are very concerned with the Town spending more than its revenue amounts. General discussion continued.
