- 3. Treasurer's report: \$709 in account
- 4. Spring Bike Bus planning
 - a. Ken Pottel gave update on Spaghetti Dinner Fundraiser planned for Monday March 24th from 5:30-7PM at Elisabeth's restaurant. Tickets were dispensed to be sold at \$10 per adult, \$5 for children 11 and under.
