

**Bikeway Committee Minutes**  
**May 21, 2015**

Meeting started at 7:00 pm

1. A quorum was not in attendance; therefore, no votes on any items occurred. However, the agenda items were reviewed.
2. April 16, 2015 minutes were not voted on because of no quorum.
2. Treasures Report: \$1,936.02 in account
3. CPC Bill – Sconticut Neck Crossing Art. 6H-Precast Specialties Corp. \$366.00. The members in attendance signed the bill. Bill Roth will get other members signature so the bill can get paid.

10. Bike Computers – Discussion occurred on what to do with the remaining bike computers. It was suggested to give them out at the next Bike Bus and if any are left over to have them for the booth at Homecoming.
11. Geoff discussed the bike rack request from the Buzzards Bay Coalition at the beginning of the Nasketucket Path. No more racks are available from SRPEDD. Can check to see if one of the old bike racks is still at BPW.
