MEETING OF THE FAIRHAVEN BOARD OF HEALTH July 14, 2010

A regular meeting of the Board of Health was held at the Town Hall on Wednesday, July 14, 2010. The meeting was duly posted. Board members present were: Peter DeTerra, Dolores Caton and Jeannine Lopes. Also present: Patricia Fowle, Health Agent.

Mr. DeTerra, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. The Chairman requested the minutes of the meeting of June 28, 2010 be amended or approved.

Motion to approve the minutes of June 28, 2010 was made by Ms. Caton; seconded by Ms. Lopes. Vote was unanimous.

The Board reviewed a septic system inspection report for 67 Nakata Avenue prepared by Ronald Arruda, Fairhaven Honeywagon, 30 Bay Street, Fairhaven. The system passed the inspection.

Motion to approve the inspection report was made by Ms. Lopes; seconded by Ms. Caton. Vote was unanimous.

The Board reviewed a proposed plan to raze 172 Balsam Street and replace with a new raised two-bedroom dwelling. The plans indicate a 2^{nd} floor landing that offers no privacy and is intended to be used as an office.

Motion to approve the plans dated July 2, 2010 as drawn for 172 Balsam Street was made by Ms. Lopes; seconded by Ms. Caton. Vote was unanimous.

The health agent reported on two restaurant inspections she recently performed at Peking Palace and Dorothy Cox's Candies. Follow-up inspections are required for both establishments. The Board reviewed the written reports. Discussion ensued. The Board intends to accompany the health agent on at least one of the re-inspections.

The Board signed for invoices from fiscal year 2010 and 2011. The Board signed the payroll as presented.

There being no other business before the Board, motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 PM was made by Ms. Lopes; seconded by Ms. Caton. Vote was unanimous.
