Financial report: read by Mr. Despres and accepted on a motion by Mr. Oliveira/Ms. Isaksen.

Academy Building report: the proposed CPC accessibility project was discussed. The option to split the project into two phases, due to the availability of funds, was debated with the consensus being that the new entry on the north side should be done first.

FireMuseum report: Mr. Oliveira will contact the contractor to request that the windows be made usable.

Fort Phoenix project: Mr. Despres stated that he is waiting to hear from Clearwater as to the status of the parapet project. Two contractors have expressed an interest. Mr. Lavalette reports that the new led lights have been purchased and are awaiting installation by DPW.

Old Stone School report: Mr. Despres reports that the moldings have been repaired and the gutters have been cleaned.

House Plaques/Historical markers: Mrs. McNaughten stated that she believes the correct date for 45 William St is 1831. Mrs. McNaughten suggested that the Town's wharfs be marked with plaques. Mrs. Mcnaughton will work with Ms. Isaksen to develop this idea.

Demo Delay bylaw: Mr. Despres will be attending the Planning Board meeting on Dec 13.

Revere Bell location: Mr. Brady requested the Commissions input as to the location. The consensus as to a preferred location was the south/west corner of William and Center Streets on the lawn of the Town Hall, with an alternate location of the Library lawn
