- A. Open Space:

- B. Stormwater program: Mel reported on the Impervious Cover Issue on Route #1. This is the problem of stormwater containing pollutants flowing from the shopping center to Mill Creek and then into Mussell Cove.
 - 1. A plan has been submitted to the Town Engineer and FCC is a project partner.
- C. Planning Board: Colin reported that only minor projects have come before the Board.
- D. Invasive Plant Species:
 - Nancy presented the latest draft of the newspaper insert/brochure and welcomed suggestions. Good suggestions were received and will be incorporated into the brochure. We will try to have the final draft at our next FCC meeting.
 - 2. Sarah will investigate giving presentations on invasive plants to local garden clubs.
 - 3. Susan will ask the Tidewater Association to allow us to make a presentation on invasive plants to them.
 - 4. We will try to put the brochure into a power point program.
