

Highland Lake Conservation Project Phase II 2004-2007 Highlights

Project Goal: To reduce erosion and export of sediment and phosphorus into Highland Lake.

This was accomplished by installing best management practices on 63 sites and promoting watershed stewardship.

We met our goal through:

1. Education

- Conducted three workshops
- Developed newsletter articles, press releases, flyers
- Installed watershed boundary signs/education signs
- Two Lake Association Annual Meeting Presentations
- Town presentations

2. Technical Assistance

- 145 technical assistance visits completed
 - Properties were assessed, site conditions and specific recommendations were summarized in reports

3. On-the-ground fixes

- 13 high and medium priority private road sites
- 2 beach/boat access
- 11 driveways
- 24 buffers
- 50 residential conservation practices

Youth Conservation Corps

- Installed over 200 Best Management Practices on private and public roads and on residential properties throughout the grant project.
