
Recycling

January 10, 2008

Beginning August 15, 2007 the Town of Falmouth instituted a curbside recycling program. The goal of the program was to increase Falmouth's recycling rate from 35% to 50%.

Recycling at Schools:

Starting in November all schools except for the High School received 5 X 96 gallon Totes for recyclables. The High School has a Silver Bullet on site. The Town delivered 82 blue recycle bins to Plummer-Motz, Lunt and the Middle School which were placed in class rooms and common areas. Custodial staff empty the recycle bins into the 96 gallon totes which are then brought outside for emptying by Pine Tree Waste.

The Recycling Committee is scheduled to meet Monday, January 14, 2008. If necessary, a revised report will be sent to the Council after the meeting.
