He is the former Chair of the FMI Store Development Committee, which he served on for 7 years. He has made invaluable contributions to the successful expansion of our family of stores. He has consistently – and accurately – identified and voiced the needs of our customers as we have grown our stores and improved our ability to leverage research to make informed decisions that are consumer focused. Additionally, Steve's consumer positioning research ultimately formed the basis for the development and evolution of our Festival of the Senses strategy and previously led to the development of our first combination store formats, our Sun Foods price formats, and more recently the 35k.

Steven joined Hannaford in 1979 as a research analyst. He was promoted in 1981 to Senior Research Analyst and in 1985 to Manager of Site Location Research. Steve was named Director of Research in January of 1989 and Vice President of Site Location Research in 1990. Over the years, his duties included leadership of the Financial Analysis function, the Strategic Knowledge Department and the Consumer Research function. 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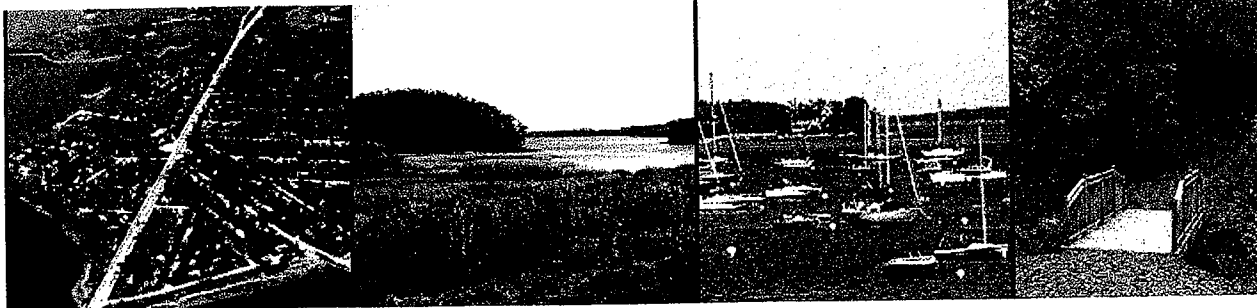

Ms. Fenrich is expert in all aspects of Federal, state, and local contracts. She has over 30 years of experience selling and managing government programs. She is a recognized industry leader in business development, acquisition strategies, managed services contracting, and performance based contracting. As a consultant she has assisted clients in winning several major contracts. Among her accomplishments was the capture of NMCI, the largest IT contract ever awarded by the Federal government.

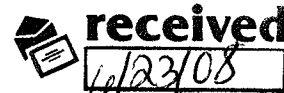

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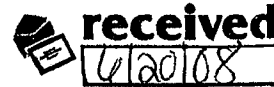
