During his 27 years with Hannaford, Steve has acquired broad expertise in his field and diverse institutional knowledge of our company and industry. He has consistently – and accurately – identified and voiced the needs of our customers as we have grown our stores and improved our ability to leverage research to make informed decisions that are consumer focused. Additionally, Steve's consumer positioning research ultimately formed the basis for the development and evolution of our Festival of the Senses strategy and previously led to the development of our first combination store formats, our Sun Foods price formats, and more recently the 35k.

Steven joined Hannaford in 1979 as a research analyst. He was promoted in 1981 to Senior Research Analyst and in 1985 to Manager of Site Location Research. Steve was named Director of Research in January of 1989 and Vice President of Site Location Research in 1990. Over the years, his duties included leadership of the Financial Analysis function, the Strategic Knowledge Department and the Consumer Research function. As VP of Research, his recent responsibilities have included long-term strategies for geographic expansion and acquisitions, research on store formats, pricing and go to market strategies, sales estimates and analyses of future real estate locations, sales analysis and sales budgeting for annual retail budgets, three-year plan projections and consumer and positioning research.

Prior to joining Hannaford, Steve served as land use planner for the Greater Portland Council of Governments, and as a consultant in economic and market research. He holds a bachelor's degree in Sociology from the University of Southern Maine and a master's degree of business administration in Marketing and Marketing Research from the University of Southern Maine.

Steve will be starting a new venture as a retail shopping center developer and consultant, which will leverage both his research expertise and his interest in real estate development and will hopefully still be helping Hannaford grow in new and existing markets for years to come. Steve resides in Falmouth with his two sons Casey, 22 and Max, 17.

Ms. Fenrich is expert in all aspects of Federal, state, and local contracts. She has over 30 years of experience selling and managing government programs. She is a recognized industry leader in business development, acquisition strategies, managed services contracting, and performance based contracting. As a consultant she has assisted clients in winning several major contracts. Among her accomplishments was the capture of NMCI, the largest IT contract ever awarded by the Federal government.

Over the years, Ms. Fenrich has addressed numerous audiences on Federal acquisition policy and procurement practices, including Federal CIO Council, Defense Systems Acquisition College, GSA Seat Management Symposium, and Connecting Technologies Conferences. Recently, she has led seminars on mastering the fundamentals of performance based contracts, service level agreements, and managed services contracts.

In October 2000, EDS received award of a fixed price, \$6.9 billion contract to build and operate an intranet for 360,000 personnel of the Navy and Marine Corps, the largest information technology contract ever awarded by the Federal government. Ms. Fenrich served as Capture Manger for the win, responsible for strategy, risk analysis, pricing, and day-to-day management of a 100 plus person proposal team. Subsequent to the win, Ms. Fenrich assumed the role of Chief Financial Officer (CFO) for the program. As CFO, she managed a staff of over 200 responsible for business, legal and contracts, human relations, subcontracts, security, facilities, training, and public affairs

<u>Electronic Data Systems (EDS) – Senior Vice President of Business Development, EDS Government, (1995-2000)</u>

Ms. Fenrich oversaw business development in pursuit of the corporation's Federal, state and local business. She managed the bid & proposal (B&P) budget, competitive analysis, pricing strategy and proposal activities. She focused on the business development process from initial lead through award. In her first two years, she reduced B&P expenditures by 50% and increased the win rate significantly by establishing strong project management processes and tools. She was instrumental in such wins as DSOS (\$260M), TELIS (\$370M), D-SIDDOMS (\$250M) and STARS (\$280M).

For example, she managed a four-year analysis for the State of California of its criminal and juvenile justice systems. In all, Ms. Fenrich provided management consultation and training to over 100 public and private organizations throughout the United States.




