TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH:

You are hereby notified that a referendum in this municipality will be held at the Falmouth High School, 74 Woodville Road in Falmouth at 7:00 a.m. on November 4, 2008, for the purpose of determining the following article:

Article 1: Do you favor approving the school administrative reorganization plan prepared by the Falmouth/MSAD # 51 Reorganization Planning Committee to reorganize the Town of Falmouth and Maine School Administrative District No. 51 into a regional school unit, with an effective date of July 1, 2009?

The voting on Article 1 shall be by secret ballot referendum and the polls shall be opened immediately at 7:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list, to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
