<b>Clearwater Drive “Gateway” upgrade</b>	Route 1 to Farm Gate Lane	\$336,000	2014	Road reconstruction between Route 1 and Hat Trick Drive. This road is located inside the TIF district.

<b>Falmouth Road reconstruction with pedestrian amenities</b>	Bucknam to Merrill	\$667,000 \$333,000	2011 2012	Unfunded future MDOT project. Not in current Town work plan. Pedestrian amenities TBD. Town to pay local share plus any pedestrian costs. While this project is not located in the TIF district, it is related to it. Increased traffic on Falmouth to and from the TIF district and a resulting concern for pedestrian safety has triggered these sidewalk improvement requirements. First portion is between Blueberry Road and Bucknam Road. Second portion is between Blueberry Road and Merrill Road.
