Falmouth Parks and Public Works Department

Operations and Departmental Structure

The Parks and Public Works Department consists of the following divisions:

- Street and Right-of-Ways
- Parks and Open Space
- Solid Waste
- ✤ Vehicle Maintenance

The Public Works Division maintains approximately 90 miles of roads and right-of-ways. Responsibilities include:

- Street plowing, sweeping, line painting, roadside mowing, signage, etc.
- Drainage system operations and maintenance

The Parks Division maintains all the Town's parks, open spaces, and town-owned properties. Responsibilities include:

- ✤ Maintenance of parks, athletic fields, trails, cemeteries, ice rinks, parking lots, etc.
- Mowing, turf/tree maintenance, weed and pest control, irrigation systems management, plowing/sanding, etc.

The Solid Waste Division manages the following:

- Solid Waste Collection
- Transfer Station operations
- Recycling operations

The Vehicle Maintenance staff performs the Town's fleet management.

Municipal and School Departments

Departmental Work Includes:

- Capital improvement projects (paving, reconstruction, bike/ped., parks, etc.)
- Development review of planning board projects
- Stormwater management (DEP permitting and compliance, ISWG member)
- PACTS technical committee representative/DOT coordination
- Recycling Committee staff liaison
- Asset/Infrastructure Management (roads, sidewalks, and storm drain system)
