Based on our discussion, it is the Department's position that this pit is not jurisdictional. In addition, if the pit slopes are stable and exhibit tree growth, we do not require the operator to regrade the slope to a shallower grade. It does not make any sense to redisturb an area that is already stable. I hope this information is helpful. If you any additional questions please let me know.
