You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of the Town of Falmouth of the referendum described in this warrant.

TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH:

You are hereby notified that a referendum in this municipality will be held at the Falmouth High School, 74 Woodville Road in Falmouth at 7:00 am until 8:00 pm on June 9, 2009, for the purpose of determining the following question:

Question 1: Do you favor approving the Town of Falmouth school budget for the upcoming school year that was adopted at the Town Council meeting held May 26, 2009?

The voting on Question 1 shall be by secret ballot referendum and the polls shall be opened immediately at 7:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list, to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.

Absentee ballots processing will begin at 9:00 a.m. and run consecutively throughout the day at the polls at Falmouth High School, 74 Woodville Road.
