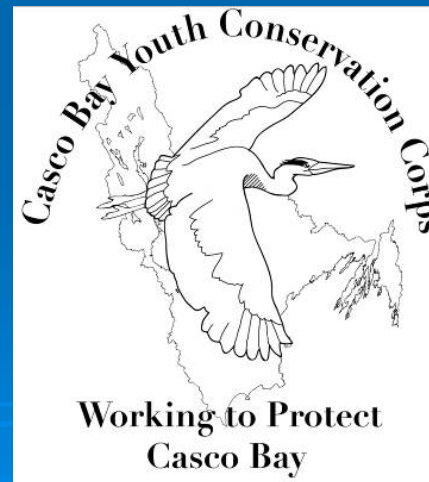

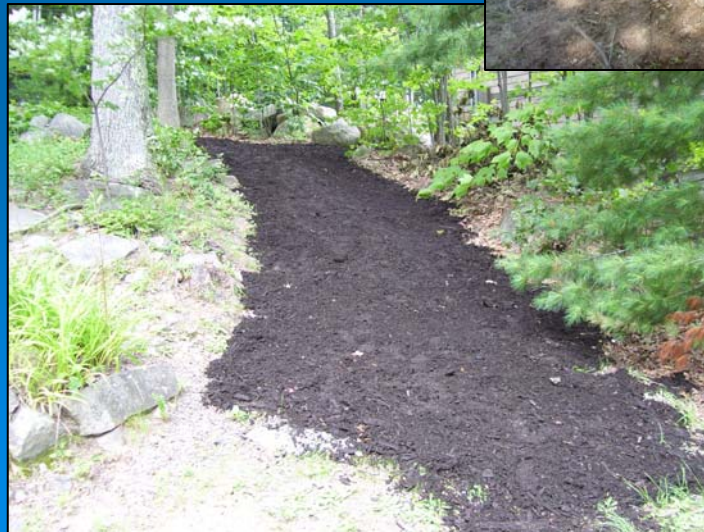


What does the CBYCC do?

Summer 2009 Accomplishments

- Planted 491 shrubs, groundcovers, and perennials.
- Constructed 11 dripline trenches , 7 infiltration trenches, and 8 dry wells to infiltrate road and roof runoff.
- Built 4 sets of infiltration steps to direct foot traffic and stabilize slopes.
- Installed 4 rubber razors to divert driveway runoff to stable areas for infiltration.
- Spread 36 yards of erosion control mulch.



- Stenciled 257 storm drains.

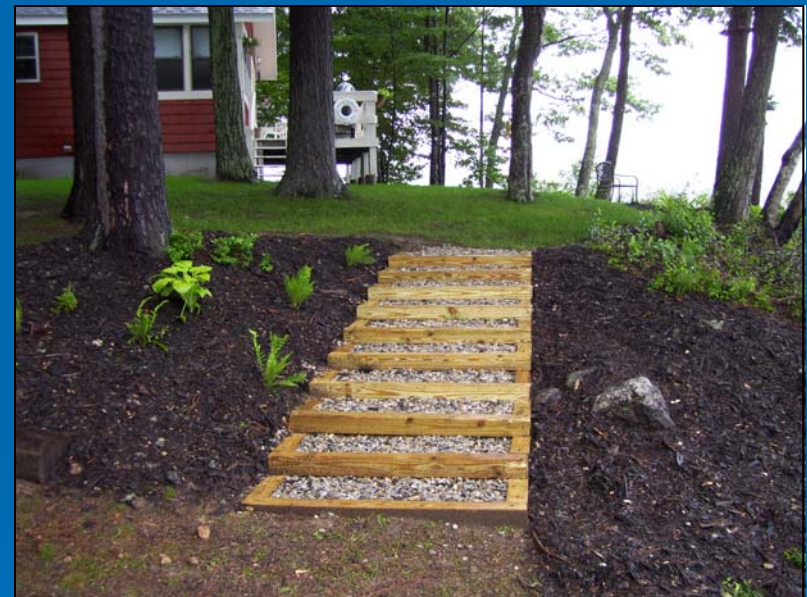

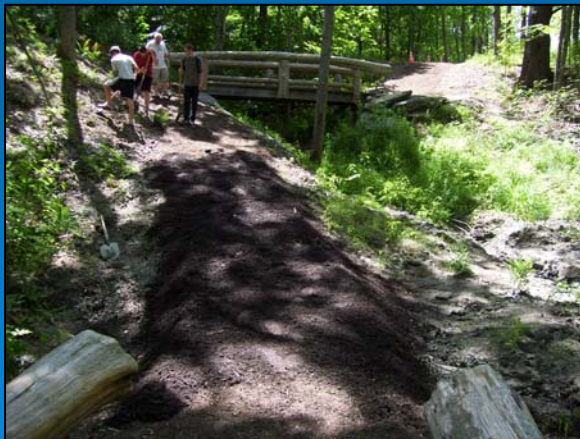
