We met last night and discussed this. We decided that the ZBA supports the Town Council's consideration of this new type of variance. We talked about several recent variance requests within the past two or so years.

The members felt this type of variance would be an additional helpful tool in addressing applicants' requests.

Here is our view of the likelihood that the new type of variance would have changed any decision we have made within the past two or so years: The members' opinions vary. The opinions range from "highly unlikely" to "there is the possibility on one or two" that we may have made a different decision.

However, there was a unanimous feeling that, if this new type of variance is adopted, some seekers of variances may misapprehend its scope and flood the ZBA with variance requests that really may still not have merit.
