**Item 18:** Order to adopt a resolution of intent relative to the acceptance of roads

On motion (Olson), duly seconded (Goggin), it was VOTED (7 Ayes) as follows:

"For the council to adopt a resolution indicating its intent to review and amend the current road acceptance standards; to appoint a committee; to have a copy of the resolution provided to future applicants for subdivision approvals in the Planning office."

On motion (Goggin), duly seconded (Vamvakias), it was VOTED (7 Ayes) as follows:

"The council wishes to put the public on notice that it may elect to make the change in the road acceptance standards retroactive to tonight's date, that any applicant who has not had a substantial review as of this date may be subject to such change in road acceptance standards."
