AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COASTAL WATERS ORDINANCE CONCERNING
THE USE OF MOORINGS FOR DINGHIES, KAYAKS, CANOES AND OTHER SMALL
VESSELS

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Falmouth, Maine in Town Council assembled that section 9-94 of the Code of Ordinances, Town of Falmouth, Maine be amended as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 9-94.c.3 is amended to read as follows:

(3) The type of boat, i.e., sail, power, inboard or outboard. *Dinghies, kayaks, canoes and similar small, low profile vessels do not qualify for mooring assignments.*

Sec. 2. A new subsection 9-94.w is added to read as follows:

(w) Temporary attachment of dinghies and small vessels.

Persons with moorings in the Anchorage may tie up their dinghy, kayak, canoe or other low profile vessel to their mooring for periods of not more than seven (7) consecutive days when the vessel listed in their mooring application is off the mooring. Tie up for longer periods is allowed only with prior permission of the Harbormaster.
