

Registration Appeals Board

Municipalities with a population of 5,000 or more must have a Registration Appeals Board to hear appeals of persons aggrieved by a decision of the registrar to either remove a name from the voting list or refuse to place a name on the voting list.

The Board consists of 3 members appointed by the Municipal Officers.

The Chair is nominated by the municipal clerk, and serves a 4 year term.

Two members are nominated by the major political parties, and serve 3 year terms.

The 2 members of the board nominated by the municipal committees of the major political parties may be members of the municipal committee nominating them and of the county or state committees of the political party that nominates them and may be members of a state or county delegation to a political convention.

When a municipal committee nominates a member to the registration appeals board, it shall also nominate an alternate board member, who serves if the member nominated by the municipal committee is or becomes unable to serve.
