Order Relating to Renovation of Plummer-Motz/Lunt School Referendum

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2011 the Town Council adopted an order entitled ORDER AUTHORIZING THE RENOVATION OF THE PLUMMER-MOTZ/LUNT SCHOOL COMPLEX INTO A COMMUNITY CENTER, RELOCATED FALMOUTH MEMORIAL LIBRARY, AND LEASABLE SPACE AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED FIVE MILLION SIX HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,650,000) USING UP TO \$1,500,000 FROM THE TOWN'S UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE AND OTHER AVAILABLE SOURCES, BUT NOT INCLUDING NEW PROPERTY TAX REVENUES; and

WHEREAS, Section 903 of the Town Charter requires that the Order be submitted to the voters of the Town following a public hearing;

WHEREAS, the Town Council held a public hearing on the Order at its regular meeting held April 25, 2011;

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH BE IT HEREBY ORDERED:

THAT said Order be submitted to the voters of the Town of Falmouth for adoption or repeal at a municipal election on June 14, 2011;

THAT the question be submitted with a statement that the Town Council recommends the Order be approved;

THAT the Town Manager, Treasurer and Clerk be and hereby are authorized and directed to undertake all action necessary or appropriate to place said Order before the voters at such election.
