Question 3: Shall the Order entitled “Order Authorizing: (i) an Energy Conservation Project at Falmouth Middle School including the installation of a Biomass Boiler and the construction of a storage building and related facilities and improvements with a total project cost not to exceed \$1,995,000 (“THE PROJECT”), (ii) acceptance of a Federal United States Department of Agriculture Grant administered by the Maine Department of Conservation in an estimated amount of up to \$500,000 to provide financing for the project and (iii) the issuance of Bonds, Notes or Lease Purchase Agreements in the amount not to exceed \$1,200,000 (plus issuance costs)(which issuance is conditioned on the acceptance of the foregoing Grant) to finance the project with the balance of project costs to be paid with funds from the previously established Falmouth Schools Capital Reserve Fund” be adopted?
