AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE USE AND SALE OF CONSUMER FIREWORKS IN THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Falmouth, Maine, in Town Council assembled, that the Falmouth Code is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered Sec. 10-4, which said section reads as follows:

Sec. 10-4. Use and sale of consumer fireworks prohibited.

(a) A person may not use, sell or offer for sale consumer fireworks, as defined in 8 M.R.S.A. §221-A, in the Town.

(b) In addition to applicable penalties provided by 8 M.R.S.A. §223-A, violation of the provisions of this section is a civil violation punishable in accordance with section 1-14. The Town Police Department may confiscate and dispose of any consumer fireworks that are in violation of this section.

(c) Pursuant to 8 M.R.S.A. §227-B, nothing in this section shall be construed to limit or regulate fireworks displays, as defined in 8 M.R.S.A. §221-A, or the issuance of permits for fireworks displays by the Maine Commissioner of Public Safety or a designee.

The Town Clerk is ORDERED to provide to the Office of the State Fire Marshall a copy of this ordinance within 60 days of adoption.
