Public Works Projects Planned for 2014

As requested, the following is a list of projects that are currently planned for the 2014 construction season:

- 1. Route 1 Infrastructure Project: Currently under construction.
- 2. Blackstrap Road Reconstruction: The project area is between Hamlin Road and Hardy Road. The project involves drainage and roadway improvements. Road upgrades will allow for this road segment to be eligible for federal and state funding in the future. Construction to begin mid-June.
- 3. Hurricane Road Rehabilitation: The project involves rebuilding the section of Hurricane Road near Forest View Drive and Blackstrap Road, where the current roadway condition is extremely poor. The remaining portion of Hurricane Road will also receive some drainage improvements and repaving to Gray Road. Currently under construction.
- 4. Leighton Road Repaying: Repaying of Leighton Road between Falmouth Road and Gray Road. This is a PACTS project that has been programmed since 2012. Paving to occur in June.
- 5. Annual Paving: This year's annual paving list is as follows:
  - a. Woods Road (Woodlands Drive to Woodville Road)
  - b. Middle Road (Maine Turnpike overpass to Lunt Road)
  - c. Leighton Road (Brook Road to Gray Road)
  - d. Casco Terrace
  - e. Other Miscellaneous Repairs Throughout Town
- 6. Railroad Crossings: Safety measures to be implemented at the following locations: Blackstrap Road, Falmouth Road, Field Road, and Woodville Road.
- 7. Falmouth Road Bridge Repairs (Maine Turnpike Authority): MTA will be reparing the turnpike spur overpass/bridge on Falmouth Road (near Woodville Road).
- 8. Summit Natural Gas: Natural Gas Pipeline expansion throughout Falmouth in 2014, 2015, and 2016.
