ARTICLE 2: Shall the District accept and place on file the reports of the auditors, agents, committees, and officers chosen to conduct the prudent affairs of the district? A6T

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Farmington School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Sixteen Million, Three Hundred Seventeen Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty Three (\$16,317,923). Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Sixteen Million, Nine Hundred Fifty Six Thousand, One Hundred Thirty Five (\$16,956,135) which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Farmington School District or by law, or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only? **NOTE:** This operating budget warrant article does not include appropriations contained in ANY other warrant articles. 341

ARTICLE 4: Shall the Farmington School District adopt a School Administrative Unit budget of Eight Hundred Sixty Three Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen (\$863,913.) for the forthcoming fiscal year in which Seven Hundred Forty Five Thousand One Hundred and Six (\$745,106.) is assigned to the school budget of this school district? This year's adjusted budget of Seven Hundred Eighty Nine Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Seven (\$789,327.) assigned to the school budget of this school district, will be adopted if the article does not receive a majority vote of all the school district voters voting in this School Administrative Unit. 125
