7:00 PM Selectmen signed the Quitclaim Deed for map 7 lot 3 to Mountain Maintenance Corporation as voted on at the March 2005 Town Meeting.

McAuley discussed the response back from Town Counsel regarding the Tony Clark property on Greenfield Road. A "friendly" letter format will be mailed this week. There will be one mailed certified, return receipt requested, with another one mailed through regular mail.


McAuley contacted Primex to discuss the Accidental Death Insurance Policy the Town had with USI for the Volunteer Fire Department. According to Primex, this is duplicate coverage. Anderson stated this discussion to be tabled until the next meeting when Griffin is present.

7:15 PM Becky Moul on behalf of WDC requested a separate paper container for \$80.00/month. Each haul is \$210.00, and they are hauling more often, because more people are recycling. The haul amount is the same for one haul or a tandem haul. Right now we are only pulling one container at time, with another paper container we can have a tandem pull either plastic and paper, or paper and paper. The Highway Dept. at their convenience can do the switch out with the loader. Anderson asked if the existing budget could handle this, Moul replied yes it wasn't going to cost us anything more because they would be tandem pulls. Anderson made the motion to approve the request for an additional paper container at \$80.00 per month, McAuley seconded, voice vote 2-0.

Moul also discussed an open house that will be held at the transfer station on Saturday June 7th from 10-4. They are inviting vendors to attend. Also Household Hazardous Waste day is scheduled for Saturday September 20th. T. Anderson will write the ad for the newspaper and Moul will modify last years contract to create the bid specs. Moul also discussed there will be a vacancy in the WDC this year and the timing of when officers are elected.
