Meeting Minutes December 13, 2010

The meeting being properly posted, and McAuley, Hardwick and S. Carbee present constituting a quorum, McAuley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The Board met with Chuck Rolph who has been working on obtaining a milfoil grant for Scoby Pond. The Town has been awarded the grant, which will cover 30% of the cost. Mr. Rolph received two bids one from Lycott Environmental and one from Aquatic Control Technology. After a brief discussion and upon Mr. Rolph's recommendation the Board agreed to accept the proposal from Aquatic Control Technology. The Board will proceed with a warrant article. Mr. Rolph advised that he would not be available to speak at Town Meeting but offered his assistance to the Board to prepare for the meeting.

McAuley, based on the recommendation of Cross Country Appraisal Group moved to approve the settlement offer with Susan and Charles Blattman. Hardwick seconded. Approved.

The Board approved the Town Hall rental application from Catherine Naun.

McAuley moved to participate in the DRA and UNH mosaic parcel map project. Hardwick seconded. Approved.

McAuley moved to approve the Selectmen minutes dated 11/29/2010 and 12/06/2010. Hardwick seconded. Approved.

S. Carbee asked if the reconditioned water truck would be able to be put undercover this winter. Unknown will check with Gary.

The Board inquired about the status of the Farrell case, Camirand, the Francestown Village Store (no building permit) and the Jackson driveway erosion issue on County Road North. Sherry will contact Peter Hopkins.
