## APPROVED MINUTES

March 3, 2008

A regular meeting of the Conservation Commission was held in the Town Offices on Monday, March 3, 2007 and called to order at 7:40 p.m.

The proposed minutes of the 2/4/08 meeting were approved with one modification.

## **Old Business**

- 1. The full moon snowshoe hike held last Saturday night was quite successful, with 12 adventurous attendees.
- 2. Chair Hardwick will meet with Gerri Bernstein and others regarding the next programs in the Joan Hanchett Nature Series. Ideas include a beaver presentation (Matt Tarr did one recently in Hancock); a Pond Life live presentation perhaps in Aug-Sept with nets, buckets and microscopes; and a Winter Wildlife and/or Winter Survival program next winter.
- 3. The Commission discussed the proposals for consideration at the 2008 Town Meeting. Various maps will be displayed for peoples' interests.
- 4. The annual stewardship monitoring reports for the LCHIP properties are being finalized for submission.
- 5. Several projects were proposed for the first landing in the Town Forest: fertilization of the apple trees, and new protective fencing on certain of the more mature trees.

## New Business

- 6. Planned Earth Day Events on Saturday, May 3 include: a clean-up event, leaving from the Town Hall, where refreshments will be served. FLT will plan to offer their support. A table could be set up with various conservation publications and miscellany. A contest to find the most unusual piece of garbage discarded by the roadside will be included again this year.
- 7. Shuffleton moved to adjourn at 9:30. Lindgren seconded the motion. All in favor.
