New Business:

- 1. Linda Kunhardt presented a Habitat Proposal for the Fringed Gentian area at the old area.
  - This would include removal of the pine saplings on the South side of the road, as a 1st phase of the plan.
  - Next would be to pull, or otherwise remove the Autumn Olive from the flat area. Approximately 150 trees would have to be removed.
  - Phase 2 would be the clearing of the area further into the woods.
- The ConCom agrees that this plan be started, as a way to protect the Fringed Gentians, which have been prolific in this area, more in some years than others.
- Ted Graham has approached the ConCom with a proposal to produce a brochure of conserved areas, showing the trails for public use. The ConCom does not want to pursue a conserved areas map.
- 3. Time to order the seedlings for school distribution. It was decided to try and get 100 each of Red and Yellow Osier.
- 4. BJ asked if the ConCom or town would please check the brook on Rte. 47, beyond her house. There is a serious problem of erosion from the road.
