- 4. Fund Raising

  - d. Lemonade stand. Elly mentioned we need to ask permission from BOS. Will do Saturday's for July and August. Picnic table to horse shed. 11-1 pm. Lemonade and cookie for a dollar. Ruth will make basket of goodies to sell. (t-shirts, coasters, magnets, mugs) Need paper cups. Michele has napkins.

  - e. Need another fund raiser. Think about options.
  - f. Bennington is working on an afghan. BJ went to their event. It was very welcoming and exciting to be so warmly greeting. The afghan has 50% return.
