The meeting was called by the Chair at 7:10 pm, in THE LIBRARY. On several motions made and seconded, it was unanimously

attend the Trustee Orientation in Dublin on April 9, from 5 – 8 pm.

Librarian's Report: 355 patrons circulated 302 fiction and 36 non-fiction books; 84 magazines, 26 audio books and 13 videos. Four paperback books were donated. The copier earned \$2.10. Carol attended a meeting of children's librarians (CHILIS) where the New Hampshire wing has joined the national group. Carol will apply for a grant to fund a performer for the summer reading program. Congratulations to Barbara Ballou at New Boston Library who was named NH Children's Librarian of the Year. We will co-sponsor the Francestown Egg Hunt on Sunday, the fifth; a program on organic gardening on May 9th will be part of the Hanchett Nature Series; the summer reading program begins at the end of June. Carol introduced Kathy Marx who has offered to do a "mural" set of drawings in the children's area. Carol will coordinate the project in the stairwell to the lower level with imput from children. Our thanks to Kathy.

Fund Raising: Linda Roche submitted a proposal for a Library Cookbook from Gail MacInnes. At very little money risked, the return should be profitable. The proposal called for community recipes and could be ready for publication mid-summer. The Board welcomed the project and all agreed to help.

Renovation project: Exactly a year ago, we moved the Library to the Town Hall in preparation for the renovation. We are grateful to Tony and the men from the NH Department of Correction for the peeling, priming and painting done over the last two weeks. Our costs are for paint, supplies and lunches. Andy had prepared a "fit-out list" to complete the project. Mike has sent sketches for shelving to NHDC. We will get bids to finish the interior painting and carpentry, and contact Phinney to finish plumbing. Erika will see to our certificate of occupancy. Mike will check elevator inspection. Our hope is for opening before the end of spring.

There was no public comment. There was no further business. The meeting adjourned at 9:20.
