**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
SCENIC ROAD HEARING**

You are hereby notified that at a public meeting of the Frankestown Planning Board to be held at 6:30 pm on **Tuesday, August 21, 2018** in the Town Offices Meeting Room Lower Level, 27 Main Street, the following agenda item is scheduled:

- A public hearing at which a request for scenic road cutting will be formally made to the board, reviewed and may be acted upon.

The Town of Frankestown proposes to conduct normal roadside vegetation work along a portion of Old County Road South from its intersection with Stevens Road, south to the turnaround and all of Journey's End Road. Both are town designated scenic roads. NO trees will be cut. Work consists solely of tree limb trimming and removal of brush by means of chainsaws and/or by hand. The timeframe for this work is expected to occur intermittently over the course of the next year. The request is for an extended approval of 12 months during which to complete the general trimming.

Interested parties are invited to attend, in person, or by agent, to show why this application should, or should not, be approved. If not resolved at this meeting, the matter may be continued to subsequent meetings without further published notice.
