

Minutes of June 9th, 2009

Meeting opened at 7:00pm

Today Becky, Paul and Tom Anderson accepted an award from the NRRA. It was presented to the town for the most recycling per capita for towns of 1001 to 5000 residents. The plaque has been given to Paul. He has volunteered to make a case for it so it can be displayed securely at the transfer station.

Tom asked to be heard. He thanked the commission for all their hard work and congratulated them on the award.

Review of Minutes:

Scott motions to accept minutes of May 13th as written. Becky seconds, all in favor.

Becky passed out the spreadsheet of employee hours. The heavy weeks (28hrs) are due to the burn pile. Weeks that they didn't burn 2 employees are over the budgeted number of hours. The board recommends the employees put a note on their timesheet to indicate what was done during the extra hours worked. Bring to the Selectmen's attention.

Tom, Becky & Sherry went thru the budget numbers. Things seem to be in order. Sherry is faxing the bills to Becky and she is designating the account numbers. The budget was fixed and Sherry and Becky will be working together on the billing, therefore they felt no need for Tom & Sherry to come to our meeting.

Mike Petrovick presented the final drawing of the Transfer Station Recycling Building. There were a couple of minor changes. He will make a final drawing and provide large ones for the commission to give to contractors for a quote. Mike recommended T-111 material for the outside instead of clapboard. It would be much cheaper and as effective.

The commission will go to the Selectmen with the plans to get their approval before proceeding. Becky to get WDC on the agenda for June 22. The employee hours will also be discussed at that time.

2009 Hazardous Waste Bid:

Becky informed commission that Tom has contacted the Hazardous Waste people from last year. According to the 1987 Town report if we are pleased with a contractor we can approach them to work for us again without putting the work out to bid.

Becky had communication with Bonnie concerning metal. We will be paid \$70 per ton to have it removed. Becky to inform Tom and recommend having it hauled away.

Paul motions to adjourn the meeting, Scott seconds, all in favor.
