Becky presented a posting notice for the WDC monthly meetings. It will take the place of having to post every month. Scott motions we accept the posting notice, Sara seconds; all in favor. It will go up after the  $9^{th}$  of March.

<u>Household Hazardous Waste Day (HHWD)</u>: We have the support of the Conservation Commission for holding a Household Hazardous Waste Day on an annual basis. It was voted anonymously on the Feb. 1, 2010 meeting the WDC attended. Scott made a presentation to the Fire Dept on Feb 17, 2010. They too give their support for an annual HHWD.

It is a real safety issue.

Becky will contact Chief Kulgren and Bob Lundgrin and ask each to prepare a one minute or so statement why they support the HHWD and putting the \$5000 back in the budget for this service.

Becky will start when they get to the Transfer Station budget at Town Meeting by motioning to put \$5000 back in the HHWD budget line item. Someone from our commission will second and the discussion will begin.

Both Becky and Scott's terms are up. Both plan on re-joining the Commission. We do need to replace Paul Ellis though. Becky has suggested contacting the young John Arnold. Sara & Scott agreed he is approachable, young, a male and first & foremost a true believer in recycling.

We have checks made out to NH the Beautiful for the green recycle bins. We would like to get signs made with that money and pay the Garden Club back from the misc. budget line. Sara is going to figure out the bin money and checks. She will report back next month.
