# CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE MINUTES OF MEETING

## The Committee reviewed the following requests:

## Replacement of Two SPED Vans for $\mathbf{\$ 5 4 , 0 0 0}$

These will replace two ten-year old SPED vans. This is part of a long term replacement plan started last year. The plan is to replace two a year for four years, and then after a period of time, replace one per year.

## Town Technology- \$20,000.

Tim Raposa requests to replace aging servers.

## School Technology

Tim Raposa requests, several items including smart boards, computers and other technology improvements/replacements.

Tim also discussed the request by the facilities department to install fiber between all school and town buildings. The proposed costs is $\$ 350,000$. The Cable TV Committee agreed to fund $\$ 200,000$. This would save the Town $\$ 50,000$ in phone bills and reduce the number of servers throughout the system.

Town Facilities - Request for replacement of carpet in Library local history room and the activity room for $\$ 20,000$. The total cost will be higher, but the Library trustees will pay the additional funds from their state aid account.

School Facilities $\$ 355,000$. - $\$ 220,000$ for a security system at the Keller Sullivan School and $\$ 135,000$ for new pavement for Parmenter School in conjunction with the reconstruction of Wachusetts Street.

The Committee will take these requests under advisement.
