Call to order 6:36 PM.

- Accept and approve meeting minutes (5/16/11)
- Pre-lottery examination of sign-ups per category
 - Discussion about application duplicates per household. Only 1 application per household permitted. Removed duplicate applicants before lottery began, so those households do not have higher percentage chance of getting a bed than other applicants. 1st applicant per household remain in lottery, 2nd removed. Sorted the list by address and removed duplicate.
 - Next year, make it more obvious that only 1 applicant per household will be accepted. We should send letters to those applicants and explain why they were removed. # 33, 57, 12, 36, 41, 63, 10, and 51 removed.
 - Left 57 left in the lottery.
 - Categories—only 1 accessible application, and 1 community groups. Motion to place them in the beds. 2nd. We placed them.
 - Made calls to clarify whether people who put an organization down—but put “general public” were actually an organization. They were all general public.
- Approval of bed counts based on registration numbers
 - Motion to make the remaining accessible and community org beds general public. 2nd. Approved. The number of beds open to general public is now 40 beds instead of the original 30. There are 55 remaining applicants for the general lottery.
- Lottery for King Street Garden
 - Placed #'s 1-65 into random.org. Ellen Williamson, Franklin resident and applicant, pressed the submit button. The website spit out a list of numbers in random order. If a # comes up that is a # for a discarded applicant, then we will move on to next number.
 - Amy calls out numbers, Deb assigns to bed on the spreadsheet.
 - Once completed, Deb calls the numbers. Amy enters the bed number for that applicant into the spreadsheet. Once all bed numbers are assigned, the remaining applicants receive a number in the wait list in the order for which they were listed on random.org.
