Town Issues/Committee Issues:

- Water should be on by now we need to check.

- o Gardeners have already been working some beds planted.

 more info.

- 2015 Season (Renewals/New Gardeners):

- o 5 people moved from waitlist into beds, several from last year who said they were renewing have not done so yet.
- O Unclear how many empty beds we have as we are waiting on some renewals. We may have as many as 5-6 spaces.
- o All confirmed gardeners are entered into email list.

- Events (Planning/Discussion):

- o Pea planting event 4/18 did not take place Chris was sick and weather was not good.
- o Franklin local TV will be covering 5/23 event for us, may get lots of good exposure!
- o Ed Szymanski wants to speak about pollinators but 6/20 date does not work for him. Kiernan is checking to see if a Sunday would be better.
- o Franklin Downtown Partnership has advised cost is \$100 for table at Strawberry Stroll; if Friends join FDP, table is free. We will pass this info on to the Friends.

New Business:

- O Chris will be advising new gardeners re: importance of active pest management in organic gardening we may want to consider changing our bylaws to specify that if a bed is infested and neglected we can take action.
- o Also considering having a "pest education" event but we have done those in past and attendance was not good. Email may work better.
