Lastly, she mentioned that the Friends of Franklin Library will hold a book sale this Saturday at the DPW garage.

Their next meeting will be June 4th. Mrs. Rohrbach noted that the Budget Sub-Committee met yesterday. They discussed the Budget Hearing that will occur tomorrow evening with the Town Council as well as cafeteria pricing. She further noted that she will bring cafeteria pricing to the full Committee at a future meeting.
