RE:	Recommended Funding Sources for the Firefighters Arbitration Award

This memo follows up on the memo sent to the Council on June 10 conveying my support for and seeking the Council's approval of the Firefighters Award. The Council is well aware of the issues in this case. All members received a copy of the award shortly after its issuance.

I recommend the Council transfer the following sums of money to fund the Arbitration Award:

FY 15 Wage Settlement Account	\$415,000
FY 15 Health Insurance Account	\$ 55,000
Total	<u>\$470,000</u>

The attached resolution transfers the funds from the Wage Settlement (\$415,000) and the Health Insurance account (\$55,000) to the Fire Department Salary Account which has \$55,000 available to fund the award of \$525,000.

SUBJECT: Town Administrator Requests Council Approval of the Firefighters' Arbitration Award

We recently received the Arbitration Award for Franklin Permanent Firefighters Bargaining Agreement covering the period of FY12 through FY 15. The award granted the firefighters an 8% wage increase over four (4) years as follows:

FY12	\$600 lump sum
FY13	1.5 % across the board increase
FY14	3.0 % across the board increase
FY15	3.5 % across the board increase

There were two additional minor changes:

- For the Union: Allow use of six (6) sick leave shifts after use of holiday and personal time to care for family members, on an approved Family and Medical Leave.
- For the Town: Flat rate paramedic stipend of \$6,000 for firefighters hired after the date of this award.

The cost to fund the Arbitrator's award for FY12 through FY15 is approximately \$525,000, plus \$70,000 for FY16.

For your information the Town has set aside \$415,000 to cover costs through FY15 based on the Town's offer for this contract. I will identify where the additional funds will come from prior to the next meeting.
