J. LEGISLATION FOR ACTION

1. <u>Resolution 16-15: Authorization to Enter into Separate Intermunicipal Agreements</u> <u>Between Franklin and The Towns of Bellingham, Medway, Norfolk and Wrentham</u> <u>to Provide Public Safety Mutual Aid</u>

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the intermunicipal agreement between area towns to provide public safety mutual aid. *Approved 9-0*.

2. <u>Resolution 16-16:Authorization For Disposition (Sale) of Town-Owned Land on</u> <u>Pond Street</u>

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council authorized the disposition of town-owned land on Pond Street. *Approved 6-3 (No: Pfeffer, Mercer, Jones).* 3. <u>Zoning Bylaw Amendment 16-753: Zoning Map Changes From Single</u> <u>Family Residential IV to General Residential V in an Area on or Near West</u> <u>Central Street - **Referral to Planning Board**</u>

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved legislation to refer to the Planning Board a zoning map change near West Central Street. *Approved 8-0. (Councilor Bissanti abstained from this item and left the Council Chamber)*

4. <u>Bylaw Amendment 16-754: Chapter 47, Alcoholic Beverages - 1st Reading</u>

<u>AMENDMENT:</u> Councilor Jones MOVED and Councilor Bissanti SECONDED an amendment to move the effective to date to July 1, 2016, replacing September 1, 2016. *Amendment Rejected 2-7 (No: Kelly, Mercer, Pfeffer, Pellegri, Padula, Dellorco, Vallee)*.

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved a first reading of a new bylaw mandating all alcohol licensees conduct training for all of their employees who serve alcohol. *Approved 9-0*.

5. <u>Bylaw Amendment 16-755: Chapter 179, Water Charges-Water Department</u> <u>Access – 2nd Reading</u>

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the second reading of a bylaw amendment to develop a system of accountability for households who do not allow town officials to update water meters in their homes. *Approved 9-0.*

6. <u>Bylaw Amendment 16-756: Chapter 170 Vehicles and Traffic Article X Winter</u> <u>Storm Overnight Parking – 2nd Reading</u>

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the second reading of a bylaw amendment to prohibit parking in municipal owned parking lots during snow emergencies. *Approved 9-0*.
