 - 1. <u>Resolution 16-17: Ratification of AFSCME Local 1298, Public</u> Telecommunications

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council ratified a new contract with the AFSCME Local 1298, Public telecommunications. *Approved 8-0*.

2. <u>Resolution 16-18: Appropriation: Elections Expenses</u>

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the elections expenses for the Town Clerk due unforeseen expenses relative to the extended Presidential Primary election. *Approved 8-0*.

3. Resolution 16-19: Appropriation: Veteran's Benefits

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved \$50,000 for additional Veteran's health care benefits for the current Fiscal Year. 75% of these funds will be reimbursed by the state. *Approved 8-0*.

4. Resolution 16-20: Appropriate and Authorize the Borrowing of Funds to Pay Costs of the Construction of Sidewalks and Related Work – 2/3 Vote

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the bond authorization for the construction of \$1.8 million in sidewalks for the Pleasant Street, Chestnut Street and Griffin Road corridor. *Approved 8-0*.

5. Resolution 16-21: Appropriation: Fire Truck Stabilization Fund

ACTION: The Council approved the appropriation for the fire truck stabilization fund. *Approved 8-0.*

6. <u>Resolution 16-22: Appropriation: Athletic Fields Capital Improvement</u> Stabilization Fund

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the appropriation for the athletic field's stabilization fund. *Approved 8-0*.

7. Resolution 16-23: Appropriation: Capital, FY 16

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the FY16 Capital Plan investing \$1.9 million in the town's infrastructure. *Approved 8-0*.

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved a \$1.3 million investment in the town's water systems infrastructure. *Approved 8-0*.

9. Resolution 16-25: Appropriation: Sewer Enterprise Capital FY 16

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved a \$1.2 million investment in the town's sewer systems infrastructure. **Approved 8-0**.

10. Resolution 16-26: Appropriation: Recreation Improvements

ACTION: The Council approved \$50,000 to make improvements to Pisani field, Dacey Field, FHS/Beaver turf, King Street Memorial Park and Remington. *Approved 8-0*.

11. <u>Bylaw Amendment 16-757: Amending the Code of the Town of Franklin by Adding</u>
<u>a New Chapter to Require That Property Owners Provide Notification to Public</u>
<u>Safety Officials of the Existence of Certain Structures And/Or Uses</u> – **1**st **Reading**

<u>ACTION</u>: The Council approved the first reading of a bylaw to require that commercial facilities with solar panels on certain flat roofs provide reflective notification to inform emergency personnel of the potential dangers when responding to emergencies. *Approved 8-0*.
