### I. SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

#### J. LEGISLATION FOR ACTION

- 1. <u>Resolution 16-31: DPW Road Construction and Maintenance</u> Simple majority vote
- **ACTION:** The Council approved a reallocation of \$375,000 that was set aside for this year's snow and ice removal to fund additional road maintenance in Town. *Approved 9-0*.
  - 2. <u>Bylaw Amendment 16-759: Amendment of Service Fees: Solid Waste and Recycling</u> 1<sup>st</sup> Reading (Motion to move Bylaw Amendment 16-759 to a 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading, Simple Majority)
- **AMENDMENT:** The Council approved an amendment to the First Reading of a bylaw amendment to maintain the small totter fee at \$180, rather than increasing the fee to \$184. *Approved 9-0*.
- **ACTION:** The Council approved a First Reading of a bylaw amendment, as amended by the Council, to increase the refuse fee from \$200 to \$204. *Approved 9-0*.
  - Zoning Bylaw Amendment 16-753: Zoning Map Changes from Single Family Residential IV to General Residential V in an Area on or near West Central Street – Continued 1<sup>st</sup> Reading (Motion to move Zoning Bylaw Amendment 16-753 to a 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading, Simple Majority vote)

**ACTION:** The Council approved a second reading of a town bylaw amendment to rezone an area of land off West Central Street. *Approved 7-1.* (*Yes*: Kelly, Vallee, Pfeffer, Mercer, Pellegri, Jones, Dellorco, *No*: Padula; Councilor Bissanti recused himself from this debate and exited the Chamber during debate).

4. <u>Resolution 16-32: Compensation Plan – FY 2017</u> – Simple majority vote

ACTION: The Council moved to continue this item to the next agenda. Approved 9-0.
