8. Zoning Bylaw Amendment 16-753: Zoning Map Changes from Single Family Residential IV to General Residential V in an Area on or near West Central Street – 2nd Reading (Motion to adopt Zoning Bylaw Amendment 16-753 - Roll Call 2/3 majority-6 votes)

ACTION: The Council moved this topic to their July Council meeting. *Approved 6-0.* (Councilor Bissanti recused himself and left the Chamber)

9. <u>Bylaw Amendment 16-759: Amendment of Service Fees: Solid Waste and Recycling</u> – 2nd Reading (Motion to adopt Bylaw Amendment 16-759 - Roll Call - Simple Majority)

ACTION: The Council approved the second amendment to an amended Town Bylaw, increasing the refuse fee from \$200 to \$204, offsetting the costs of doing business for the Town's refuse contracts. By contrast, refuse fee in 2005 was \$300. *Approved 7-0*.

10. <u>Bylaw Amendment 16-760: Amendment to Water System Map</u> – 1st Reading (Motion to move Bylaw Amendment 16-760 to a 2nd Reading - Simple Majority)

ACTION: The Council approved the first reading of a bylaw amendment to amend the water system map. *Approved 7-0*.

11. <u>Bylaw Amendment 16-761: Amendment to Sewer System Map</u> – 1st Reading (Motion to move Bylaw Amendment 16-761 to a 2nd Reading – Simple Majority)

ACTION: The Council approved the first reading of a bylaw amendment to amend the water system map. *Approved 7-0*.
