- Recommended budgets by department were recited. Total Operating Budget = \$105,559,492
- Question raised (MD) regarding Fire Department staffing levels and use of overtime versus new hires. Points discussed:
 - o 2 new assisted living developments add to call volume
 - o Reduction in productivity, morale
 - o Could we add full time personnel instead of budgeting overtime expenses?
 - o Response times are up
 - Workforce is aging
 - o Adding a full time staff member creates legacy costs
 - With pending retirement of some Fire Department staff, new recruits may help to reduce the overtime expenses
 - o Collective bargaining agreements are still pending
 - Overtime is not evenly distributed, but always tracked
 - o With overtime, fire fighters work approximately 95 shifts per year
